Spring Spa

Synopsis of Events:

- Mr. Callahan explained on June 20, 2017 the Norwalk Police Special Service Unit executed a search and seizure warrant of Spring Spa at 430 Main Ave Apt. 2.
- Norwalk Police raided Spring Spa and arrest Zhongfeng Liu for practicing massage therapy without a license a violation of CTGS 20-206 a-c and prostitution CTGS 53a-82.

Mr. Callahan explained the Board is able to take action on this matter and suspend or revoke Spring Spa's permit.

Dr. Quell moved and Mr. Lalime seconded a motion to suspend the massage establishment permit for violations of the Norwalk Massage Establishments ordinance section 65-9 D-E, non-licensed employee without a background check and section 65-21-I endangering the public health, safety, and welfare. The motion passed unanimously. Mr. Callahan will notify the owner of the permit suspension and the date for a hearing on this matter.
