Officer Haggerty stabilized the injury until the arrival of the Norwalk ambulance service.

Chief Kulhawik stated that Lieutenant James Walsh and Officer Taranjit Singh apprehended several car thieves who were the occupants of a stolen SUV out of Bridgeport, Connecticut. Their quick response ensured that the perpetrators did not engage in a high speed chase or elude capture.
