Reconstruction of Rowayton Avenue at Metro North Railroad Bridge

WHEREAS, the City of Norwalk, CT has published a legal notice display ad, mailed a news release to a number of officials and agencies, and mailed a formal letter to abutting property owners, announcing a public informational meeting on the proposed project for the "Reconstruction of Rowayton Avenue at Metro North Railroad Bridge No. 4132R (ConnDOT Project No. 102-H065); and

WHEREAS, a public informational meeting was held on April 22, 2009 from 7:00 PM to 8:30 PM in City Hall, at which residents and elected officials had the opportunity to voice their concerns; and

WHEREAS, the South Western Regional Planning Agency has endorsed this project; and

WHEREAS, the Norwalk, CT Common Council has considered the concerns of residents from the public informational meeting and finds that the proposed project, Reconstruction of Rowayton Avneue at Metro North Railroad Bridge No. 4132R (ConnDOT Project No. 102-H065) is in the best interest of the City of Norwalk, CT and will promote the health, safety and general welfare of its residents and provide for the convenience and safety of the motoring public and pedestrian traffic.
