**2019 TRANSFER STATION HOLIDAY SCHEDULE**

The Transfer Station will be CLOSED on the following holidays:

New Year's Day: Tuesday, January 1, 2019  
Memorial Day: Monday, May 27, 2019  
Independence Day: Thursday, July 4, 2019  
Labor Day: Monday, Sept. 2, 2019  
Thanksgiving: Thursday, Nov. 28, 2019  
Christmas Day: Wednesday, December 25, 2019

**Passenger Vehicles (Cars & SUVs) must have a valid Resident Pass visible on the windshield, available from the Parks Department at City Hall or online at the City website.**

Trucks, pick-up trucks, vans, and vehicles pulling trailers require a Residential or Commercial Disposal Permit (Public Works Department) for regular use of the Transfer Station or Yard Waste Site.

**Trucks, pickups, vans and vehicles with trailers will be weighed at all times.**

There is a minimum charge of \$20 for each use if the vehicle has no residential or commercial permit, otherwise \$85/ton.

**Items for DISPOSAL at the Transfer Station**

- Regular household / business trash
- Recycling separated
- Bulky items (furniture, carpet, mattress, etc.)
- Dimensional wood and wooden items (4 feet or smaller)
- Latex paint (dried & solid only)

**Items for RECYCLING at the Transfer Station**

**Cardboard Compactor**

- Flattened Corrugated Cardboard

**Single Stream Container**

- Newspaper, magazines & catalogs, junk mail
- Mixed papers, cereal boxes, empty food boxes  
Hardcover, paperback, phone books
- Glass food or beverage containers
- Metal food or beverage containers
- Plastic bottles or containers

**Rigid Plastic Container**

- Large Items (no number required), toys, laundry baskets

**Cooking Oil Container**

- Used Cooking Oil

**Electronic Waste Container**

- TV, computer monitor & tower, printer, cell phones, or anything with video screen (toy, fish finder)

**Batteries**

- Lithium batteries: See DPW Fee Schedule
- Vehicle batteries/ lead acid
- Alkaline batteries (e.g. AA, C, D, etc.)

**Waste Oil/ Antifreeze**

- Waste Oil: 5 gallon max
- Antifreeze: See DPW Fee Schedule; 5 gallon max
- Oil Filters: 3 filters max per day

**Freon Appliances**

- Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers: See DPW Fee Schedule; 3 appliances max per day

**Tires**

- Tires (Car/ Truck): See DPW Fee Schedule

**Bulk Metal**

- Bulky metal items & appliances  
(NOT Freon containing)

**Propane Tanks Enclosure**

- Propane Tanks (less than 25 lbs): See DPW Fee Schedule

**Items NOT ACCEPTED at the Transfer Station**

- **Asphalt Shingles & Sheetrock**
- **Brick, block, cement or asphalt rubble**
- **Ceramic items (sinks, toilets, tile)**
- **Counter Tops (Corian, Laminate, etc)**
- **Asbestos containing materials**
- **Ammunition or Explosives**
- **Fluorescent bulbs: CFL or Tube (Home Depot & Lowes will accept unbroken bulbs)**
- **Hazardous Materials : Please ask for Household Hazardous Waste Day Flyer or visit website**
