Mayor Rilling Provides Local Update on Coronavirus

(Norwalk, Conn.) - City officials are working closely with partners at the state and federal levels, as well as partners in Norwalk, to monitor and respond to COVID-19, the 2019 novel Coronavirus. Statewide updates can be found online at ct.gov/coronavirus. Mayor Rilling provided the following Norwalk-area specific updates regarding COVID-19 coronavirus as of 4:30 p.m. on Friday, July 3, 2020:

- Since yesterday, there are no new positive cases in Norwalk, and the total positive reported cases remains at 2,082. There were no new deaths reported.
- Due to a steady decrease in new COVID-19 infections, the Norwalk Hospital (Nuvance Health) drive-through COVID-19 specimen collection site will be shut down this weekend. Testing will be transitioned onsite this month.
- The first of the “backyard” Norwalk Summer Concert Series is tonight at 7 and kicks-off the Fourth of July weekend. The “Salute to America” show will be broadcast on Facebook beginning at 7 p.m. Visit facebook.com/norwalkrecreation to tune-in.
- Despite recent rainfall, the area is still experiencing dry conditions. Water demands are incredibly high, especially due to COVID-19, with more people home for prolonged periods of time. Local officials encourage residents to conserve water where possible. Visit epa.gov for water saving tips.


“Demand for water is up and it is important for residents to conserve where possible. We are all being mindful of COVID-19, and washing our hands more frequently, but we should try and stop the water instead of letting it run for 20 or 30 seconds,” Mayor Rilling said. “Tonight is our first backyard concert and I hope the public will join us for the “Salute to America” concert at 7. This will be a beautiful way to start the Fourth of July weekend.”


Number of Norwalk COVID-19 Cases by Date of Specimen Collection
