Mayor Rilling Provides Local Update on Coronavirus

(Norwalk, Conn.) - City officials are working closely with partners at the state and federal levels, as well as partners in Norwalk, to monitor and respond to COVID-19, the 2019 novel Coronavirus. Statewide updates can be found online at ct.gov/coronavirus. Mayor Rilling provided the following Norwalk-area specific updates regarding COVID-19 coronavirus as of 5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 24, 2020:

- Since yesterday, there are two new positive cases in Norwalk, bringing the total positive reported cases to 2,162. There were no new deaths reported.
- COVID-19 community testing is available at the Day Street Community Health Center, 49 Day Street in Norwalk, Monday - Friday, 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. No appointment or referral is needed and testing is free. This week, mobile testing will be held at The Marvin, 60 Gregory Blvd. from 9:30 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Tuesday, August 25; Meadow Gardens, 49 Meadow Street from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. on Thursday, August 27; Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji Foundation, 622 West Ave. from 4 p.m. - 7 p.m. on Friday, August 28; and at 40 South Main St. from 12 p.m. - 3 p.m. on Saturday, August 29. Testing is available for those with or without symptoms. More information is available at chc1.com.
- Following a recent spike in COVID-19 cases in Danbury, Conn., Danbury Public Schools announced today that instead of beginning the academic year under a hybrid model of in-person and remote learning, all instruction will be provided remotely until at least October 1.
- The Wheels2U microtransit service in Norwalk has returned under new rules. The service is available Thursday from 5 p.m. - 10 p.m., Friday and Saturday 5 p.m. - midnight and Sunday noon - 9 p.m. Ridership capacity is 50% of normal, and masks/face coverings must be worn at all times. - The eighth and final week of the Norwalk Adventure Clubs is this week. The free online programming has activities for all ages and interests. A few highlights this week include show and tell for 2 - 5 year olds on August 25 beginning at 10 a.m.; all-ages bingo on August 26 at 10 a.m.; blog writing for teens and adults on August 27 at 7:30 p.m.; and pipe cleaner crafts for all ages at 12:45 p.m. on August 28. 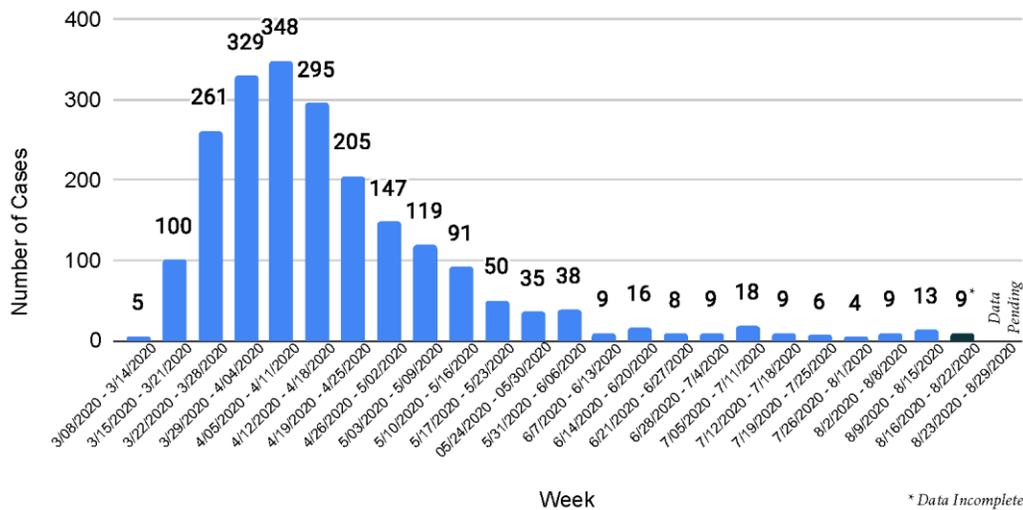

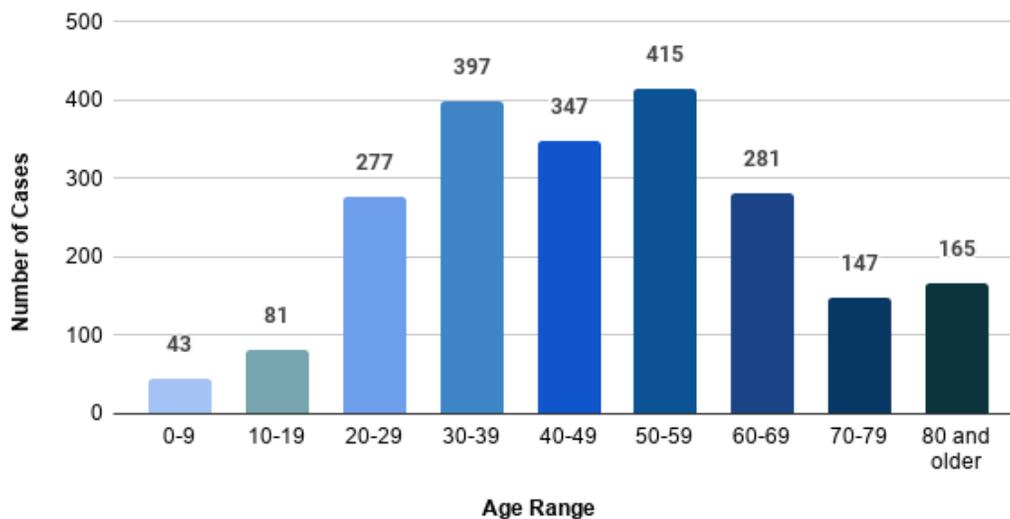
Number of Norwalk COVID-19 Cases by Date of Specimen Collection
