WPCA CAM Review

The Water Pollution Control Authority for the City of Norwalk has completed its review of the March 9, 2021, Latest Revision: September 14, 2021, engineering drawings prepared by D'Andrea Surveying & Engineering, PC for the proposed elevation and improvements to the existing single family residential dwelling to be located at 19 South Beach Drive.

The project is approved by the WPCA with the following conditions:

1. WPCA approval or payment of the sewer connection fees for increased system burden is required. Please contact Dilene Byrd at (203) 854-3228 to fulfill this condition.
 - a. Submit the size and quantity of existing and proposed water meter(s) for the project.
2. **No** discharge to the sanitary sewer, or any other dewatering activities to the sanitary sewer is permitted during construction without contacting the WPCA (Ralph Kolb at 203-854-3242).
 - a. Discharge to the sanitary sewer system requires WPCA approval, and a Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection General Permit.
 - b. Please contact DPW Permits or Code Enforcement for any discharges to the storm drain system.
3. Submit all revisions in the form of a signed and sealed plan to WPCA for review.
4. WPCA approval shall be valid for a period of 12 months from the date of this approval letter. Any permit issued on the basis of this approval must be issued within such 12 month period. Any renewal of the plan approval will be based on the then existing conditions and current applicable regulations, ordinances and standards of practice in effect at the time of the renewal request.
