COLD CASE INVESTIGATIONS

CASE: 90-31532

CASE TYPE: Homicide

DATE: 8-23-1990

LOCATION: 331 Ely Ave

VICTIM: Evelyn Colon – 28 yrs old



SUSPECTS: Unknown – Several persons of interest have been identified in the investigation but no firm suspects identified. One witness stated possibly a man with gray/silver wavy hair. Another witness stated he saw a black male approx. 6' tall, 150 pounds, 18-25 years of age and wearing a white painters hat walk across the yards after hearing a garbage can knocked over and a dog barking around 2:00 am.

SUMMARY: On Thursday, August 23rd, 1990 at approximately 2:00 am, the Norwalk Police received a call from the victim's 9 year old daughter that her mother had been hurt. Responding officers found Colon lying on a mattress on the floor with wounds to her head and torso. CPR was initiated by a neighbor and officers and Colon was transported to Norwalk Hospital where she was pronounced dead at 2:40 am. The autopsy reported that Colon suffered two gunshot wounds to her torso. The case remains unsolved.
