

RATE BILL

At a meeting of the Board of Estimate and Taxation of the City of Norwalk, Connecticut, legally warned and held on the 4th day of May 2015, it was voted to lay a tax on the grand list of October 1, 2014, at the following composite mill rates:


Districts 1, 2, 3, 8 and 9: **25.371** mills on the dollar;
District 4: **25.430** mills on the dollar;
District 5: **24.710** mills on the dollar;
Districts 6 and 7: **22.852** mills on the dollar;

Said taxes to become due and payable one half on or before the first day of July, 2015, and the balance on or before the first day of January, 2016; and,


District 10: **28.805** mills on the dollar;

Said taxes to become due and payable on or before the first day of July, 2015, and said supplemental taxes to become due and payable on or before the first day of January, 2016.

The foregoing rate bill is made in accordance with the above vote, and pursuant to Conn. Gen. Statute 12-130. Dated at Norwalk, Connecticut, this 4th day of May 2015:






